Please write on the entry form your qualification for the open test.

QUALIFICATION AS FOLLOWS:

OPEN Open to all dogs, of a specified breed or breeds, although, preference will be given to dogs which have gained an award or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed first, second or third in an Open Working Test, or won a novice Working Test.

NOVICE - Confined to dogs, which have not gained an award or Certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed first, second or third in an Open GWT or first in a novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club rules and Field Trial regulations.

SPECIAL PUPPY - Confined to dogs, which are under the age of two at the date of the test.

NOVICE DOG/NOVICE HANDLER - Must not have had any awards in Trials or a first in a Working Test.
